Top 5 ski towns and airports to land a private jet in the US

Winter is near and for the private aviation industry that translates into increased bookings to ski resorts in the country. **Welojets**, a private aviation company based in Miami, shares the top ski locations and regional airports that can be easily accessed on a private jet.

One of private aviation's main traits is the possibility to land close to the destination and in remote locations, avoiding large crowds at international airports. This explains why it is such a popular choice for those seeking a flawless ski experience, especially for passengers flying with their own equipment, as there are no extra fees for transporting skiing gear while also having the possibility of carrying it in the cabin, thus avoiding potential damages.

1) Breckenridge

One of the most trending ski towns in the states today, Breckenridge is a vibrant place in Colorado with various dedicated lodges. Naturally, ski is the main dish, although there are tons of other activities for those seeking a relaxed leisure holiday, from shopping, to dining and drinking. Its closing date is projected for May 2022.

Best airport to land a private jet: **Lake County Airport (LXV)**, located 44 miles from town.

2) Vail

Vail is potentially the most popular ski resort in the states today. It has the largest ski area in Colorado and offers a wide array of hospitality options, also for those looking for a luxurious touch. Vail has iconic heated sidewalks, keeping the heat just above freezing temperature to make snow removal an easier task. It is projected to close on April 2022.

Best airport to land a private jet: **Eagle County Regional Airport (EGE)**, located 35 miles from town.

3) Aspen

Even those detached from the skiing ecosystem have heard about Aspen at a global scale. In fact, even if skiing is not your thing, Aspen is worth a visit thanks to its beauty and well-prepared hospitality industry and infrastructure. It has four separate skiing areas: Aspen, Snowmass, Buttermilk, and Aspen Highlands. Closing date for 2022 is projected for April.

Best airport to land a private jet: **Aspen-Pitkin County Airport (ASE)**, located just 4 miles from town.

4) Telluride

Breathtaking views and top-notch skiing define Telluride. The town also has an amazing Wild West vibe that perfectly sets the scenery for novice or savvy skiers worldwide. It is not as popular as the previously mentioned places, which is probably the best feature for those who frequently visit the location: less crowds! The estimated closing date is April. Best airport to land a private jet: **Telluride Regional Airport (TEX)**, located just 6 miles from town.

5) Steamboat Springs

Ski and natural hot springs, what a perfect combination for a laid-back leisure holiday. That is what Steamboat offers, apart from its rustic charm. It is removed from Denver, unlike other ski resorts in Colorado, which means crowds are rare. This is the perfect scenario for private aviation to thrive, landing at remote places with smaller terminals. Projected closing date is April 2022.

Best airport to land a private jet: **Yampa Valley Regional Airport (HDN)**, located 25 miles from town.
